

The benefices of the Regents--the endowments of the teachers of the University--were swept away; and, after several years of poverty and depression, the University was reconstituted by a Charter whose provisions fell far short of the comprehensive ideal of the Continental University. The Charter of Nova Erectio (1577), granted by James VI., under the influence of the Regent Morton, --a Scottish Baron whose zeal for learning must have been an exceptional taste among his order, --set up anew the University and the Faculty of Arts. Three Regents in Arts were appointed, --one for Greek and Rhetoric; another for Dialectics, Morals, and Politics, with Arithmetic and Geometry; a third for Physiology, Geography, . Chronology, and Astrology. This was but a portion of the full curriculum in Arts...
